THINK TWICE IS IN YOUR AREA

The City of Cape Town has embarked on an innovative recycling project in your area. The purpose of the Think Twice campaign is to separate dry recyclables (paper, cans, glass, cardboard and plastics) at your home, which will be collected and taken to the City's Kraaifontein Integrated Waste Management Facility.

The process

You have been issued with a 140 ℓ recycling bin with a green lid to put your recyclables in.

Please note: This is an additional service to you and is provided **at no extra charge**.



This is what we ask of you:

- During the week, fill the 140 ℓ bin with dry waste – paper, glass, cardboard and plastics. This needs to be as dry, clean and flat as possible.
- Ensure that all your recyclables are placed in your recycling bin, and take the bin out for collection by **07:00** on the day following your normal refuse collection day. **Note: Residents whose normal collection days are on a Friday will receive this additional collection service for recyclables on a Monday.**
- With this letter you will find a bin application form which the City requires for verification purposes. Please complete and fax to 021 400 4302, or post to Solid Waste Management, PO Box 655, Cape Town 8000, or e-mail to Wastewise@capetown.gov.za or take it to the nearest municipal walk-in centre in your neighbourhood:
 - **Durbanville** (cnr. Oxford and Queen Streets)
 - **Kraaifontein** (Brighton Road)
 - **Bloemhof** (Bloemhof Road, Bellville)
 - or any other municipal office

Lastly: Disposal of waste is a costly exercise. Everything that can be diverted from landfills will benefit the environment, the City and, ultimately, you.
